Weekend Pickup

The famous JJ Markets (Chatuchak Markets) is where it all is, from t-shirts to pets to street food to thirty foot tall transformers! It's all there and like the markets this number is based on a strong serve with Mount Gay Rum then blended with fresh mint and lime, mango and passionfruit.

Mai Tai

First found in Oakland's 'Trader Vics' in 1944 the Mai Tai since became one of the globes most recognised cocktails. This Mai Tai is a top pound-for-pound fighter, and a sure bet, with the combination of dark and light Mount Gay Rum, Cointreau, Disaronno and lime.

Pina Colada

"If you like Piña-Colada", a party tune everyone can sing along to. With pineapple juice, Mount Gay Rum and coconut cream, it's a Polynesian themed dream.

Singapore Sling

A drink that almost vanished into the memories of long forgotten bartenders of the Raffles Hotel in Singapore resurfaced to become one of the world's most popular gin cocktails. Hayman's London Dry Gin, pineapple juice, lemon and cherry infused perfectly.

Margarita

Margarita Sames, a Dallas Socialite created the world's most recognised cocktail while playing her favourite party game 'Mix-and-Match'. More Tex, Less Mex, but still a great drop. el Jimador Tequila, Cointreau and lime, done right.

Long Island Iced Tea

Like most stories, the creation of the Long Island Iced Tea has long been debated. What is known is the combination of five clear spirits with a dash of cola provides more zing than the standard Earl Grey in a tea pot.

Dry Martini

Although the Martini's origins are not known, what is known is that it rose to fame during the Prohibition era. Although as prohibition was lifted and quality gin was entering America this cocktail got decidedly dryer. Made traditionally with Hayman's London Dry Gin, Dry Vermouth and the olive.

Caribbean Sunset
